

Bluegrass is coming to Crested Butte Mountain Resort on March 27

MT. CRESTED BUTTE, Colo. (Mar. 2, 2010) - The entire Gunnison Valley is celebrating Crested Butte Mountain Resort's (CBMR) announcement of a major spring bluegrass event - the first annual Ski Town Breakdown, sponsored by CBMR and Boulder-based natural and organic burrito makers EVOL Burritos.
